



Fr Manu is 40 years old, one of four siblings, and was ordained in December 2001. Fr Manu has a Bachelor of Philosophy, a Bachelor of Theology, and a Masters in Business Administration. Fr Manu has served as Parish Priest, as Director of a Boys Home, as Prinicipal of a Degree College where he taught Business Studies, and as Financial Administrator of the MSFS Theology Study House. His parish work has had a focus on pastoral care for migrants and the marginalised. Father's full name is Fr Manu Kumbidiyamackal Varkey MSFS.


