KIDS CORNER 8th May 2016 Gospel Luke 24:46-53

Ascension of the Lord Do you think they thought he would come back to them, like he did after he died on the cross? These were ordinary people, and they would have a



big job to do. They would begin to preach about Jesus to everyone. Jesus knew that they were not ready to do that, and so he promised them that God would send them help, and that they were to wait for it. Sometimes we have important things to do, and we are not sure that we can do them. Often it helps if we know that there is someone we can talk to who will help us if we get stuck. Other times, when someone we respect has confidence in us, we feel better and more confident about ourselves. Jesus knows that what he started preaching about the Kingdom, which led to his death, then his resurrection and finally his ascension into heaven - will be continued by the disciples. He knows that they are going to need a lot of help. He knows that the Holy Spirit will come to them and they will be strong. The Holy Spirit comes to us too. We received the Holy Spirit when we were baptised. The Spirit is always with us, and can help us be strong and to be good. All we have to do is be open and ask for God's help.

ROOF REPAIR AT ST JOHN XXIII We have Done it

It is a matter of great satisfaction and pleasure to inform you all that the repair works on the roof are completed. We had set a target to complete the work before the winter and I am happy to inform you that it is done. First and foremost, I would like to extend my sincere & heartfelt gratitude to those who have contributed towards this project. Without their active guidance, help, co-operation & encouragement, and financial contributions this work would not have been carried out. We are also grateful to AKB Plumbing and Roofing Pty Ltd who carried out the work within the stipulated time. All work has been completed in accordance with the specifications plus some extra faults found at the time. The plumber now wants to wait until we have a good solid windy stormy rain to check for leaks. We hope there will be none but if there are any he will come back, find and rectify them. The total cost so far is \$20,343.40, this amount came just below our actual quote as the contractor did not charge us for some of the works. The total money we had raised towards this project is \$30,101.83 dollars. There is a balance of \$9,758.43 which can be used towards some of the other important maintenance tasks. Once again thanks to all of you for all your hard work, support and contributions. God bless.

<u>Renewing Parishes Part 7</u> The Parish is led by a Pastoral Team

These small teams may involve lay leaders, religious, deacons, and priests. They may take on a variety of roles such as coordinator of the community, manager of the parish, finance officer, youth worker, as well as pastoral associate and pastoral director. Leaders in

Catholic schools will often be part of such teams. Attached to each team there will be a priest, who may be a parish priest, or a priest moderator. Other priests may be part of the team. There will be a need to plan for the teams of the future, identifying, supporting and providing learning experiences for lay leaders. Each parish will need to nurture the vocation of those called to lay ministries, as well as continuing to nurture vocations to ordained ministry. The pastoral team, along with the whole parish, will exhibit the values of openness and transparency. It is essential that the pastoral team be truly and visibly collegial, and so contribute to building up authentic communion in the parish.

OCTOBER PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

We ask this through the intercession of Mary, Mother of Mercy, you who live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit for ever and ever. Amen

Jubilee of Mercy Year 8/12/2015 to20/11/2016

Explanation of: The Plenary Indulgence In The Jubilee Year Of Mercy.

In the Jubilee of Mercy, an Indulgence is available to all who fulfil the usual requirements of receiving an Indulgence, that is, are in a state of grace by celebrating the Sacrament of Penance, celebrating Holy Eucharist with a reflection on mercy, reciting the profession of faith (Creed), offering a prayer for the intentions of the Pope and who undertake one of the following actions:

- Passing through a Door of Mercy;
- For the sick and elderly, by receiving
- Communion or attending Holy Mass and community prayer, even through various means of communication (for example, Mass via the internet)
- For prisoners, in the Chapel of Prison;
- By performing one or more of the spiritual or corporal works of mercy.

Note that the Sacrament of Penance is able to be celebrated 7 days either side of the Action of Mercy.
