Placed in the Vineyard of God....

Today's gospel makes us wonder! "What were these labourers thinking?" Surely they knew that the land and the harvest belonged to the landowner, and not to the labourers...so, too, the Kingdom of God. We labour for the Kingdom, with our works of mercy, charity and love. Yet, the results of our labours, the harvest we do not get to keep for ourselves. All of our works are for the glory of God and for the purpose of building the Kingdom. From this we can learn a lot about ourselves and how we stand in relation to God. First we see human PRIVILEGE. Like the managers of the vineyard, everything we have is a privilege and not a merit. This is what we mean when we say that everything is God's grace. Life itself is a privilege which can be taken away from any of us at any moment. Privilege comes, however, with RESPONSIBILITY. We are ultimately responsible and accountable to God for the way we use or abuse our God-given privileges. God has given us all that we need to make a judicious use of all our privileges, yet we retain the ability to abuse them. This is called FREEDOM. The Parable of the Wicked Tenants, as it is called, is a parable on the misuse of human freedom. Let us today pray for the wisdom and the courage never to abuse our privileges but rather to make a judicious use of all the privileges and opportunities that God gives us.



We will be starting our sessions soon for catechumens (not baptised) and candidates (baptised but do not have all sacraments) for R.C.I.A. The Second Vatican Council prescribed the revision of the rite of baptism of adults and decreed that the catechumenate for adults, divided into several steps, should be restored. This means the time of the catechumenate, which is intended as a period of well-suited instruction, would be sanctified by liturgical rites to be celebrated at successive intervals of time. The Council likewise decreed that both the solemn and simple rites of adult baptism should be revised, with proper attention to the restored catechumenate.
