Great, Great, Great!!!!

There are instances of three 'greats' in the gospel reading today:

A great storm, a great calm and a great fear. The disciples were threatened by superhuman devastation, but a greater power than superhuman devastation was found in the person of Jesus, who conquers it and inspires overwhelming awe.

The **great storm** not only threatened the boat but the very lives of all who were in it. Most of the disciples were professional fishermen and storms at sea were not strange to them, but that day this storm was different. That is why they were afraid and cried out to Jesus. There is not only desperation in their cry, but also a mild rebuke against Jesus for his apparent unconcern. Sometimes we find our lives are storm-tossed, conditions of life severe. Our lives like the boat may be rocked dangerously. God may seem asleep. At such times we need to cry out for help, but in serene and trustful spirit so that the **Great calm** can come about. Yes, the intervention of Jesus brought about calmness in the sea that was troubled. If we invite Jesus to intervene in our lives that great calmness will be felt in our own lives as well. The great calmness points to the control of God over the powers of nature.

That is why the sudden calmness in the sea is not only unusual but also bewildering. As long as the Lord Jesus is there with us, there is no danger, which we will not face with courage; there is no mountain, which we will not scale with success; there is no valley, which we will not cross with perseverance. When the disciples witnessed the power and authority of Jesus over the elements of the earth-the wind and the sea, they were rightly filled with **great awe**. They realised that Jesus is no ordinary person. His words and works reflect the great words and works of God as their forefathers experienced in the Old Testament. To be in the presence of Jesus is to be in the presence of God. We need to really stand in great awe as he bears that great mark of divinity. Then let us really pray with confidence: O Lord, our God, grant us in all our duties Thy help, all our perplexities Thy guidance, in all our dangers Thy protection, and in all our sorrows Thy peace; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen (St. Augustine)

The Role of Music in Sunday Mass Part 2
Given that psalms are songs, "it is preferable
for the Responsorial Psalm to be sung, at
least as far as the people's response is
concerned." 61.

The importance of Sundays and major feasts requires that every effort should be made for the psalm in the Liturgy of the Word to be sung by a cantor with the assembly singing the response. Seasonal responses are also permitted instead of only singing the response set for a particular Sunday. For instance, during Lent a response that suits the tone of the season may be used over several weeks.
