# HAPPY FATHERS DAY **FOOTPRINTS**

"Walk a little slower Daddy." Said a child so small. "I'm following in your footsteps And I don't want to fall. Sometimes your steps are very fast, Sometimes they're hard to see; So walk a little slower, Daddy, For you are leading me. Someday when I'm all grown up, You're what I want to be: Then I will have a little child Who'll want to follow me. And I would want to lead just right. And know that I was true; So walk a little slower, Daddy,







For I must follow you."

#### **Experience the God who cares!**

Today's Liturgy of the Word offers us an invitation to become humble instruments of healing in Jesus' hands by giving voice to the voiceless, the needy and the marginalised in our society. We are invited to open our ears to hear the word of God and to allow the Holy Spirit to loosen our tongues to convey the Good News of God's love and salvation to others. The first reading (Is 35:4-7), reminds us that God's eyes are constantly focused on the helpless. God especially cares for "the frightened, the blind, the deaf, the lame, the mute," and He encourages the powerless to "be strong and fearless." In the second reading (James 2:1-5) today, the apostle James gives us some basic and challenging principles of social justice. He exhorts Christians to show no partiality based on external appearance and to practice God's "preferential option for the poor." He warns the faithful against scorning or disrespecting the poor while showing special consideration to the rich. Responsorial Psalm (Ps 146) for the day, sings of a God who gives sight to the blind, raises up those who are bowed down and welcomes strangers. The psalmist thanks God and asks us to rejoice because "the God of Jacob keeps faith forever," by keeping His promise of peace and fullness of life for His people. The Gospel for our reflection today describes how Jesus, by healing a deaf and mute man, fulfils Isaiah's Messianic prophecy: "The eyes of the blind shall be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped." The ailments listed by Isaiah are very symbolic. They symbolise our interior and spiritual illnesses: blindness to the needs of our neighbour, unwillingness to hear God's voice and the inability to speak words of praise and gratitude. Through this miracle story, Mark also reminds us that no one can be a follower of the Lord without reaching out to the helpless, without having that "preferential option for the poor". Let us then, allow Jesus to heal our spiritual deafness and muteness so that we may really reach out.

#### **PLANNED GIVING ENVELOPES**

Please collect your Planned Giving Envelopes from the back of the church. Parishioners who give by Direct Debit or Credit Card can also collect their receipt and letter. This saves the Parish the cost of mailing them to you.

The new envelopes with all black writing begin next week so please destroy any old envelopes (the ones with blue and red colour) as those who had old envelopes numbered between 2 and 300 have been given different numbers.

This practice is not new. In the past this was performed every 3 years because parishioners leave and others go onto Direct Debit and Credit Card Giving leaving gaps in the system and we were having so many envelopes left over.

By changing your numbers we have been able to order 50 less sets of envelopes and therefore cut the cost to the Parish!




