Laudato Si' "Praise be to You"

'Laudato Si' is not exactly an encyclical on climate change as misunderstood by many people. Its focus is something much beyond. The central theme of the Encyclical is that the fallen nature of the human heart and the resulting brokenness of human relations is the cause of the crises in our lives, families, nations, and now the life-sustaining ecosystems that form our common home. The title comes from St. Francis's Canticle of the Creatures, which addresses Christ in gratitude for the goodness of nature. The encyclical is divided into a prologue and six chapters. It examines the problems of our age: environmental, yes, but also the breakdown of social relations. Pope Francis stresses the link between human and environmental crises, which he says "are ultimately due to the same evil: the notion that there are no indisputable truths to guide our lives, and hence human freedom is limitless." Then he elaborates the symptoms and causes of these problems. It offers a brief catechesis on the environment as seen from the "very good" creation accounts of Genesis and then through the incarnational proclamation of the Gospels, which highlights the relationship in Jesus Christ between God and creation. Pope Francis also examines the role of sin in the modern age. A Catholic response to all this is given by the Pope in the remaining part of the Encyclical and concludes with a rich array of Catholic theology and spirituality. Yes, Laudato Si' should help us to understand and offer a way out of the personal, communal, and planetary disorders of our age in the light of the salvation history.

If we consider it only as an Encyclical on climate change it becomes not so meaningful.

Don't forget to mark this day in your Diary. The day will commence with Mass at 9:30am followed by games, quizzes, chat, entertainment, music and laughs.


