For sending your only son to be our savior. Help us to know and love your truth and to listen to you always.

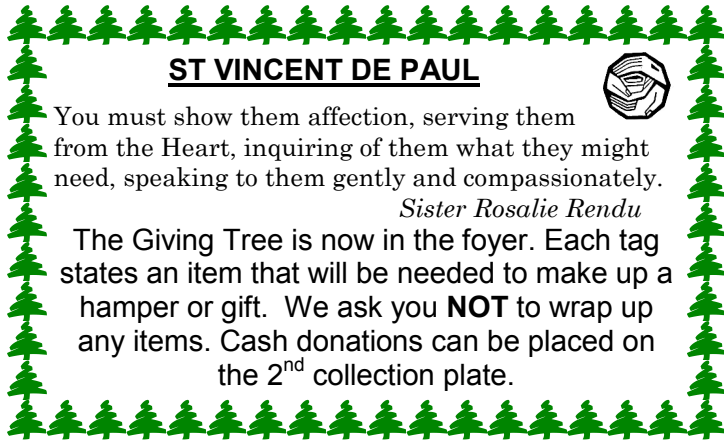

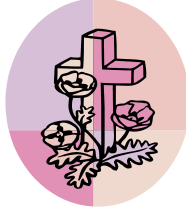
