

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: The Lord has done great things for us: we are filled with joy.





The ancestry of Jesus Christ The Jesse Tree helps us connect the custom of decorating Christmas trees to the events leading up to Jesus' birth. The Jesse Tree is named from Isaiah 11:1: "A shoot shall come out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots." Jesse was the father of King David. We adorn a Jesse Tree with illustrated ornaments that represent the people, prophesy,

and events leading up to the birth of Jesus. The ornaments of the Jesse Tree tell the story of God in the Old Testament, connecting the

Advent season with the faithfulness of God across four thousand years of history.

Prayer:

Help us, Lord to be like John the Baptist, filled with your spirit and brave enough to say and do what is right. Give us the courage to choose the right way,



despite what others might say or think, because we believe in you and love you with all our hearts. Amen
