Have You been to the Spiritual Fitness Centre?

The Liturgy of the Word today has something very special for all of us. In the first reading Prophet Isaiah sees all nations making their way to the Holy City. They come from all over the world to Jerusalem along with those who returned from exile to serve the Lord in complete joy and happiness and a new spiritual brotherhood. In the second reading we are encouraged to accept difficulties as God's discipline. Such discipline is a true opportunity to grow as true children of God. They are the indication that God loves us and corrects us as a loving parent through the pains and sufferings in our life. In the gospel we see someone asking an anxious question that has plaqued believers ever since: "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" No doubt the questioner had been with Jesus for a few days and had witnessed the anger the Lord had shown in dealing with the scribes and Pharisees, supposedly the best people of the society. Perhaps he thought to himself: "if the Lord is displeased with these paragons of virtue, how in the world can he ever be pleased with 'poor slugs' like me? In response Jesus said: The gate to heaven is a narrow gate, so only the 'thin' can enter. It seems that even Jesus is on to us to lose weight, to shed the excess. It's a narrow door we have to negotiate. To some extent entering through the narrow gate calls to mind those who have so fattened themselves with the cares and worries of life that they cannot squeeze through the door. The Gospel points out the fact that salvation is not automatic.

It requires the cooperation and perseverance on our part to secure the Kingdom of Heaven. The best chance of success is to humble oneself and serve others. It means that if we want to enter the Kingdom of Heaven we must mortify ourselves and make sacrifices. Therefore, which way shall we proceed?

"To every person there opens a way;

A high way, a middle way, and a low way. And the high soul takes the high way;

And the low soul takes the low way;

And in between on the misty flats,

The rest drift to and fro.

But to every person there opens a way

A high way, a middle way and a low way.

And every person decides

Which way his soul shall go."

May we discover daily the narrow way that leads to God! (Paraphrase of the poem by John Oxenham). As we reflect together this week, may we be mindful of those bundles, those burdens, that keep us from being all that God has called us to be. May we ask God for the true freedom we need to be children of God who walk freely toward God's kingdom of love.
