The Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales

For the last three and a half years I have been here at Para Hills Modbury and I always told you that I belong to the Congregation of the Missionaries of St Francis de Sales. Now as the Provincial of the South – West India province to which I belong is here with two of his leadership team members for a canonical visitation let me first of all, in the name of the parish community extend to them a hearty welcome. Let me also take this as an opportunity to explain to you some things about the congregation and the province. The Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales was founded by Fr. Peter Memier in 1838 at La Roche–Sur-Foron, France. The first mission territory entrusted to the new congregation in 1845 was the vast mission territory of Visakhapatnam, in India. Today members of MSFS are spread over many countries in the world, rendering valuable services to humanity by holding on to its charisma of parish preaching missions, evangelisation and education of the youth. The political disturbances in France, especially the French Revolution had its impact in the spiritual realm too as it left the people in a deep spiritual crisis and indifference towards their religious duties. Sensing the signs of the time Fr. Mermier took upon himself the task of a spiritual renewal in his people by preaching parish missions. This special apostolate in turn gave rise to a community of preachers gathered around Fr. Mermier. His firm missionary zeal was amply clear from his slogan: I want missions. Realising the need to give a formal shape to the team Fr. Mermier went ahead with the plan of forming it into a religious society. Msgr. Pierre Joseph Rey, Bishop of Annecy who was a source of constant support and inspiration to the missionaries conferred the canonical approval on the young congregation on 24th October, 1838 and entrusted it to the care and patronage of St. Francis de Sales. The mission plan of Fr. Mermier included foreign missions too and he expected Rome to entrust his little congregation with a mission in Africa. But contrary to the expectation, the vast mission territory of Visakhapatnam, in India was entrusted to the MSFS in 1845. Gradually the Congregation began to extend its missionary work to other countries as well. The MSFS mission in England began in 1861. The Fransalians grew large and began to spread out to the other parts of India. And today it has six provinces in India, viz., Visakhapatnam, South–West, South–East, North–East, Nagpur and Pune. The Fransalians have established their missions in the American countries too. In 1926 the mission in Brazil was begun. The mission in the United States was begun in 1972. In 1994 an MSFS mission was opened in Chile. In 1988 the African mission was established. The MSFS foundation there has extended their work to countries in the continent like Tanzania, Kenya, Uganda, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa, Chad, and Cameroon. The MSFS missionaries have made their presence felt in many other countries like Germany, Italy, Spain, Austria, West Indies, Philippines, Ireland, Australia etc. The South West India Province from which three priests are here in Adelaide was erected in 1991. It consists of the two states of Karnataka and Kerala in India, the Francophone countries of Chad and Cameroon in Africa and the Philippines. There are priests from the province working in all the other missions of the Congregation as well. The works of the Missionaries are carefully chosen to meet the needs of the place and time. The missionaries engage in establishing and managing parishes, schools and Colleges, orphanages and other social service centres and thus bringing the Catholic presence to places where it was not known earlier. Please always keep the congregation in your prayers.

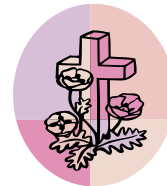

Pastoral Care Visits

Our Chaplains and Hospital visitors help to provide pastoral care for people who are admitted to hospital and are also able to follow up with pastoral care for people once they have been discharged from hospital. From time to time the chaplains and their teams become aware that a person who has been admitted to hospital has not shared this information at the local parish level (for various reasons). This can mean that ongoing pastoral care for that person may be easily overlooked when they are discharged from hospital. If you are to be admitted to hospital, please consider letting someone in the parish team know so that you will have an opportunity to be supported.

If you choose, the parish can also share this information with the respective chaplain in advance so that one of the team can visit you during your stay.
