Lenten Penance to Easter Joy

On the second Sunday of Lent we meditate on the Transfiguration of Jesus. Before going into the transfiguration event, we need first to put it into proper context. Peter had just recognised Jesus, as the expected Messiah. "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." But this was immediately followed by the declaration of Jesus that being Messiah meant not a mighty warrior-king as they expected. Rather he was going to be rejected by the leaders of his own people, arrested, tried, condemned, tortured and eventually executed. Peter had objected to this strongly and in turn, he was severely scolded for obstructing God's way of doing things. Even more, Jesus had said that, if anyone wanted to be his follower, they would have to be prepared to walk the same road of rejection, oppression and even death. It is in this depressed mood that today's experience takes place. To give a boost to their morale, he takes three of his most intimate disciples, Peter, James, and John, and goes up onto a high mountain. When they reached the top, "He was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light." In the Transfiguration, the union of God with humanity in Jesus Christ was made manifest in a special way. The veil is lifted and his disciples receive a glimpse of his divinity shining forth through his humanity and the depressed mood turns into moments of joy. Sometimes we too experience the absurdities of life such that our minds are filled with doubt and we ask, "Where is God?". Don't we sometimes feel like the whole world is collapsing on our heads? It is then that we should go up the mountain of prayer and ask God to open our eyes that we may see a glimpse of eternity to realise that all our troubles in this life are short-lived. All it takes is a little glimpse of heaven to empower us to take up our daily crosses and follow Jesus, knowing that the cross of Lent is followed by the crown of Easter. The transfiguration of Jesus is a small glimpse of the destination of the Lenten journey. It reminds us that the 'Lenten Penance' will give way to the 'Easter Joy'. It gives hope that we might reach that same destination, the abolition of death and the bringing to light of life and immortality. For our Lenten journey to be effective and fruitful, we need to have our destination in mind. There is, of course, a danger of losing sight of it, of turning our eyes away. We need Christ to lift us up, to take away our fear. We try, through our Lenten penances, to be detached from the things of this world and keep our vision fixed on Christ who touches our lives. So, let our eyes of faith be fixed on God, and let our hearts be filled with hope, and let us joyfully look forward to the ultimate glory that awaits us all.


