HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit

Today's feast invites us to live in the awareness of the presence of the Triune God within us; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The mystery of the Holy Trinity, a doctrine articulated by the ecumenical councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, is one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity and the greatest mystery of our Faith. "There is one God, Who has three Persons," Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each Person is God, yet there is still only one God" (CCC #234, #253-256). God the Father Who is the Creator, the Son, the Redeemer and the Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier and the Counsellor. The doctrine of Three Persons in one God, co-equal and co-eternal in Divinity yet distinct in Person, is not explicitly spelt out in the Bible. Even the very word "Trinity" is not found in the Bible. But the doctrine of the Trinity underlies all major Christian feasts, including Christmas, the Epiphany, Good Friday, Easter, the Ascension and Pentecost. All the official prayers of the Church, including the Holy Mass and the Sacraments, begin with an address to the Holy Trinity: "In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." We are baptised, absolved of our sins and anointed in the name of the Blessed Trinity. We bless ourselves with the Sign of the Cross, invoking the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and we conclude our prayers glorifying the Holy Trinity, saying "Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit." Today's readings convey the fundamental mystery that the Triune God reaches out to people with love, seeking the deepest communion with them. The feast of the Holy Trinity is very special to us as members of the Para Hills Modbury Catholic Parish. Our Mass Centre at Para Hills was named Holy Trinity Church 50 years ago when it was built. We are grateful to God for this house of prayer in the name of the Triune God.

I would like to wish all parishioners a Very Happy Feast of the Holy Trinity. We who are named after Holy Trinity must see the Trinity as the model for our Christian Community. We are created in love to be a community of loving people, just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are united in Love. From the day of our Baptism, we have belonged to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. How privileged are we to grow up in such a beautiful Family! Hence, let us turn to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in prayer every day. We belong to the Family (community) of the Triune God. The love, unity and joy in the relationship among the Father, Son and Holy Spirit should be the supreme model of our relationships within our Christian families and in our community. Our community becomes truly Christian when we live in a relationship of love with God and with others. The celebration of Trinity Sunday in our community should help us to respect ourselves and respect others. Our conviction of the presence of the Triune God within us and within our community should help us to esteem ourselves as God's holy dwelling place, to behave well in His holy presence, and to lead purer and holier lives, practicing acts of justice and charity. This Triune Presence should also encourage us to respect and honour others as God's dwelling place. May God bless us all in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
