#### Volunteer briefing, 14th March 2017, 5.30pm.

Did you know that all volunteers in the Adelaide Archdiocese are mandated by law to report child abuse and neglect?

In order to ensure all our volunteers are equipped to identify and respond appropriately to concerns about children and young people, we invite any volunteers who have not yet participated in Child Safe Environments training or an equivalent course to attend a 90 minute volunteer briefing session, run by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit. The session will be held at Manresa,

Norwood Parish, 137 William Street, Norwood.

The session will inform you about what the
Archdiocese is doing to safeguard children and
young people and to assist you to recognise signs of
abuse, understand how abuse and neglect impact
upon children and how to consult about, and if
necessary, report child abuse or neglect.

Please note that with respect to child-safe initiatives, as per Archdiocesan Policy, all Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist are required to provide certification of attendance at Child Safe Environments Training.
