Third Sunday of Easter... You are forgiven! A greeting of true peace

Christ's greeting to his disciples: "Peace be with you...why are you disturbed?" What does this greeting imply? To understand this we have to recall the recent past and how they all, with the exception of John, deserted him while he was being tried and crucified. So Jesus' greeting of 'peace to you' may well mean: "Let your hearts lay at rest. Let there be no self-condemnations. YOU ARE FORGIVEN. You are reconciled. You belong to me again. We are friends and I am not going to accuse you. All I want from you from now on is that you remember my forgiveness, turn away from the past, and make a new beginning. We are sure that the disciples will never forget this personal experience of divine forgiveness. They had faltered and fallen, for they were human, but from now on picking themselves up and returning to Christ they experience the peace that he offers. That same experience is now ours. We have all probably had enough falls in our life to take deep consolation from the words of Jesus spoken to us today: "Peace be with you...let your hearts be at rest...you belong to me again." Now the question is how is our personal responsiveness to divine love? Is it the same as the apostles who had the experience of the risen Christ. In the risen Lord the forgiving love of God became ultimately visible, and the apostles responded, they gave into it. Imitating that example we need to let our hearts burn within us with love for him and he will have restored us to fullness of life. That is a big message of peace, a great message of forgiveness, the greatest of all love.
