Being Fruitful Branches...remaining in the Lord and with the Lord...

This Sunday's Gospel, the Vine and the Branches, reminds us why we go for the Holy Mass. We may say that as Christians, we are Catholics. But do we understand the fact that this is more than membership in a society? Even more than membership in a family? We are united to Jesus Christ as branches are united to a vine. His Life

flows into us. We come to Mass to be nourished with His Life through Word and Eucharist. "Remain in me and I will remain in you," the Lord tells us in today's Gospel. That is what we are called to do, and that is what we do when we live the Mass.

During His ministry on earth, Jesus' presence for the sick, the sinner, and the seeker was so powerful that it transformed people's lives. Jesus became the vine that sustained the branches and made them fruitful. (cont...)

2nd Reading: John 4:7-10 Gospel: John 15:9-17

Those who take part in the Eucharistic celebration have an obligation to draw strength and energy from the Lord in the Eucharist and become "another Christ", "another Eucharist" in the community. So our presence should be really life giving for others. If we do not have anything to live for, if we do not have the desire to bring Christ to anyone, then our participation in the Eucharist will be fruitless and meaningless. The Mass is not an act of spiritual self-preservation or self-interest. The Mass is about the others. Those out there. Jesus called in order to send. We have been called to celebrate the Holy Eucharist so that we might be sent. The very word Mass means a sending. We are a Church on a mission. And so we let ourselves be transformed by the Lord in the Holy Eucharist, drawing our strength and life from the Lord, then we go with the Lord, who is with us always until the end of time to bring about a Christian transformation in this world. Yes, giving Christ to the world by the very way we live. It is a great challenge in this modern scientific, individualistic, materialistic world. Are we willing to be part of this mission of transformation?


