Parish Review

The Parish Pastoral Council has decided to conduct a broad scale parish review as we believe it to be an ideal way for the parish to continue its involvement in the Archdiocesan Renewal and to prepare for the Archdiocesan Visitation program. It will also assist us as we prepare for the Australian Plenary Council 2020 which has as its focus, what we believe God is asking of us in Australia at this time. The Parish Review will be a time of reflection on all aspects of parish life in terms of our Parish Mission, Vision and Goals and will be an honest and open look at what is working well together with considering means of improving in areas where we are less effective.

The work of the Parish Review is firmly founded in our belief in the Word of God. In John's gospel we are told: "A new commandment I give you: love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." (John 13:33-35) We believe therefore that we are called together, in mutuality, to love one another. In the writings of Paul, we are asked to reflect on our many and various gifts and to use those gifts to build each other up. Paul says to the Romans, "...you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith." (Romans 1:12)

We find in Paul's letter to the Ephesians this guidance: "Be kind to one another, tender hearted, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ has forgiven you." (Ephesians 4:32) Paul reminds us of our unique gifts and of how the Church needs and values them all. He says in 1 Corinthians, "There are varieties of gifts, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good." (1 Corinthians 12:6-7)

As Christians, our desire to serve God and His people is a response to our baptismal covenant, grounded in the model of Christ, and because we know we are both the image of God and imperfect, we enter the process of this Parish Review believing that it will help us see our Parish as it is, while seeking to make it become as Christ would have it.

We have established a Parish Review Team which is made up of the following members: Arnold Callado, Lea Crosby, Jeffin John, Diana Panicker, Mark Ryan, Phyllis Truman, Louella Walker, and Fr Manu.

The Review Team will work under the guidance of a Parish Review Steering Committee made up of the Parish Priest, the Pastoral Associate, the chair of the PFC and the chair of the PPC. The Parish Review Team met for the first time this week to set priorities for the commencement of the Review.

You are invited to read the Parish Review document which is published on the parish website. There are some hard copies of the document at the back of both Holy Trinity and St John XXIII. We will hear more about the review over the coming months.
