Background and Context

The Para Hills Modbury Catholic Parish came into being at the amalgamation of Holy Trinity Parish and John XXIII Catholic Community. The amalgamation began early in 2004 and was concluded at the end of 2004. Throughout 2004 and 2005 the new identity of the parish was formed and the work of bringing the two communities together as one has continued since then. This work included the development of the Mission and Vision statements of the Parish which you see reproduced below.

Given that it is 14 years since the inception of the Para Hills Modbury Catholic Parish following the amalgamation, the PPC thought it important that we keep these statements at the forefront of our thinking as we conduct the review.

Access to the Holy Spirit comes through a special gift that all people who are baptised have received at their Baptism when they are anointed with chrism. That gift is called "a sense for the faith" (sensus fidei). The whole Church together has this special gift, what is called "the faithful's sense of the faith" (sensus fidelium).
