USE OF ST JOHN XXIII CARPARK BY MODBURY HOSPITAL STAFF

In response to a request from Modbury Hospital the Parish Finance Council has agreed to a temporary arrangement to allow Modbury Hospital staff to park in the northern carpark only Monday to Friday for the next 6 weeks with financial compensation for the Parish. It is anticipated that up to 20 cars may park on any given day but this will not interfere with normal week day parking by parishioners as most people use the carpark close to the church. This is a temporary arrangement while the hospital investigates longer term parking solutions for its staff.

where some of our parishioners, because of a lack of volunteers are having to clean the Church three times each month.


> People to remain behind after the 8am Mass at St John XXIII or after the 10am Mass at Holy Trinity to join the counting teams.


It would be our hope that with enough volunteers you would only have to do this once per month.

There are a number of ways to contribute should you wish to:


Collection tins at each Mass centre before and after Mass.
