## Have you thought? - Teaching examples

Jesus cites several examples of the Law to demonstrate the way in which he has come to fulfil those teachings, rather than to abolish them.

He reinterprets the teachings on killing, adultery, divorce and oath-breaking.

When there is an attitude of observing the very literal meaning of law, there is a tendency to look for loopholes wherever possible.

This attitude had become the norm in Jesus' day. His reinterpretations are designed to challenge people to think about the law in a broader context and to take the law into their heart rather

than looking for ways to get around it.

Collection tins at each Mass centre before and after Mass.


Cash can be placed in an envelope


