## Mandatory Training for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

The Archbishop has written a letter to all parishes and schools regarding the new process requirements for 'Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion' in the archdiocese. He mentions that "Being an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion is a privileged ministry, and the person should be in good standing and full communion with the Church, as well as being fully compliant with Child and Young Adults Safety Legislative and Diocesan requirements. The person should be at least 18 years of age, except for when providing ministry in Schools and Colleges when 16 is acceptable."

The training is mandatory for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

Salisbury Parish is organising training for the members of the Northern Deanery with the support of the office for worship. The training is open to anybody who wishes to attend the training from any parish or school, especially in Northern Deanery. Three sessions will be available, and you may choose one.

# REFLECTION by Fr Michael Tate

### **Undoubtable Wounds**

Thomas was granted the gift of seeing the Risen Lord bearing the wounds of His crucifixion. Thomas was invited to touch them. Responding, he simply cries out: 'My Lord and my God.'

Thomas does not declare his belief in the Resurrection as such. That was all too apparent. Rather, he declares his faith in the identity of the risen Jesus Christ: 'My Lord and my God.'

Pope Francis says we can only join Thomas in this faith by touching the wounds of Christ. Those wounds are to be found in the body of someone wounded. This can be in a myriad of ways.

We have to bend down and touch those wounds in whatever means of healing is available to us. Otherwise we simply engage in philanthropy at a distance. We end up believing in a semblance of God, but not God embodied in the Risen Lord Jesus Christ always bearing his wounds.

Sometimes we struggle with our faith – after all, it is an astounding claim that Jesus of Nazareth is God embodied for us. You, or any other person intrigued by Jesus, are invited to touch the wounds of Christ and let the patience of God take care of the timing of the response of faith.

We could pause for a moment, praying to be counted amongst those who receive the Blessing promised to those who have not seen the Risen Lord as such, but who touch his wounds and proclaim, 'My Lord and my God.'

## Child Safe Environments Briefing for Volunteers

As you may be aware, all volunteers in our Archdiocese are mandated notifiers under the South Australian Child Protection Legislation. To ensure we hear the voices of children and have the necessary skills to identify and respond appropriately, we invite any volunteers who have not yet participated in Child Safe Environments training or an equivalent course to attend a 90-minute Volunteer Briefing session facilitated by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit.

A Volunteer Briefing will be held on:

Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2023 in the Adelaide Cathedral Hall, 39 Wakefield St, Adelaide TIME: 10:30am – 12:00pm.

#### If you have attended a Child Safe Environments or RRHAN training within the past 3 years you do not need to attend a Volunteer Briefing.

**Please note:** the content of the session is not suitable for children and young people (under 18 years old) to attend so please make alternative care arrangements for your children before attending a Volunteer Briefing.

There will be no free parking available at the Adelaide Cathedral Carpark on the day. However, there are a number of public car parks in the area in Gawler Place, Roper Street and at the Central Markets which offer parking for a fee. There are also public transport options with stops in Wakefield Street (bus) and Victoria Square (tram).
