FEAST DAY OF ST JOHN XXIII



***"I want to throw open the windows of the church
so that we can see out and the people can see in".***

These words of St John XXIII brought real changes
in the life of the church.

Servus servorum Dei; Servant of the servants of God.

This was Pope John's preferred title.

Patron of Papal delegates, Patriarchy of Venice, Second Vatican Council

Birth: 1881: Named Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli

1885: He entered seminary at Bergamo

1904: Ordained as a priest

1944: appointed papal Nuncio to Paris.

1953: He became cardinal-patriarch of Venice.

1958: nearly 77 years old elected as Pope.

He chose the name of John after John the Baptist and because it was his father's name, and the name of the church he was baptised in.

Pope John XXIII's pontificate lasted less than five years, but it presented him to the entire world as an authentic image of the Good Shepherd. He summoned to meet the Roman Synod, established the Commission for the Revision of the Code of Canon Law and summoned the Second Vatican Council.

Pope John XXIII died on 3rd June 1963, in a spirit of profound trust in Jesus.

Beatified: 3rd September 2000 by Pope John Paul II

Canonized: 27th April 2014 by Pope Francis I

Feast day: 11th October.

There has been a renewal of structures and processes within the Archdiocese of Adelaide.

The Archdiocese, as a response to legislation, requires that those involved with various ministries in our Church undertake regular formation in the ministries and have current Department of Human Services Working with Children Checks.

The Parish conducted training for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion in 2018 and it is now necessary to make training available to every person who intends to continue, or begin, in this ministry, including leaders of Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion. The training is one of the prerequisites to continuing in these ministries.

To make the process easy for people, the handbook has been updated and will be available in hard copy and electronically. To complete the training, you will need to submit answers to questions, either in hard copy or online, by 31 October 2023.

Participation in this ministry will be suspended until the requirements are met.
