Meet Memory from Malawi. Memory, the eldest daughter from a rural Malawian family, trained to become a carpenter and is now a trailblazer for future generations of women in her village.



We've had 13 calls for assistance for food and clothing

for 24 adults and 12 children in the last week.

Three of those were for the Dernancourt Conference, where they have a COVID issue.

Demand has continued to be strong. We've had to replenish our stocks of Drake's Gift Cards.

We haven't been able to provide assistance with bills through emergency relief funds but this may improve after March.

The Holy Trinity Hall is now in use for the "Pooraka Hub" with appointments booked

Tuesday and Friday mornings; vouchers for shopping at the Para Hills IGA are issued.

Our immediate needs in the pantry are Tinned Spaghetti, Rice, Margarine and Tinned Tomatoes.

It will greatly help if any or all of these items could be placed in the Vinnies' collection basket.



Spouses and friends are welcome to attend the presentation dinner from 6.15pm.


