

It will greatly help if any or all of these items could be placed in the Vinnies' collection basket.




Next week is Sea Sunday, when the church prays for all those who live and work at sea. There will be special collection for Stella Maris,

There will be an opportunity for the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation for adults who have been baptised but not yet confirmed.


