

St Vincent de Paul Modbury Conference

We had seven calls for assistance this last week, seven adults and three children in all. In two of the cases, a phone service disconnect and a refusal to answer prevented contact to set up a visit. Our Gift Card provision, for shopping some perishables to complement the non-perishable groceries we deliver, is still with Drake's and is our major source of expenditure. FoodBank is calling at St Luke's in Smart Road fortnightly on Wednesday mornings and we can refer people to them to get good value shopping. Spending \$30 there is like spending \$60 at Coles or similar, and bakery products are free. The referral voucher gives them ten visits over six months.

Our needs in the pantry are **Tinned Meat, Two Minute Noodles, Tinned Peas/Beans and Peanut Butter (Small).** It will greatly help if any or all of these items could be

t will greatly help if any or all of these items could be placed in the Vinnies' collection basket.

Vinnie's continues to operate an assistance centre at Para Hills, at the Holy Trinity church hall, by appointment Tuesdays and Fridays from 10:00am to 12:00pm to provide support to our companions. The roster for this two person duty is stretched thin and any volunteer help would be welcome.
