
# JUBILEE OF THE SICK & HEALTH CARE WORKERS

During Lent, our Parish is getting ready for Holy Week and the Easter Triduum. The Liturgy Committee has prepared sheets listing the volunteer ministries required at the services.

To volunteer for any of the ministries, please add your name to the list at the back of the church **as early as possible**, **and by 6 April** at the latest.

The ministry provided by many people during Holy Week and Easter is highly valued.

### The Altar of Repose During the Triduum

The altar of repose is a temporary <u>altar</u> where the <u>Communion hosts consecrated</u> on Holy [<u>Maundy</u>] <u>Thursday</u> during the <u>Mass of the Lord's Supper</u> are placed, or "<u>reserved</u>", for use on the following day, <u>Good Friday</u>.

As Good Friday is the day on which the <u>death of Christ</u> is observed, while the <u>Resurrection of Jesus</u> is observed on <u>Easter Sunday</u> and the anticipatory <u>Easter Vigil</u> on <u>Holy Saturday</u>, <u>Mass</u> may not be celebrated between these days, namely, between Good Friday and the evening Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday which is usually celebrated after sundown. Communion <u>hosts</u> thus cannot be consecrated, and any hosts used on Good Friday or for <u>viaticum</u> for the dying must have been consecrated beforehand.

During the Mass of the Lord's Supper, a sufficient number of hosts are consecrated for the faithful to receive Communion both at that Mass and at the Good Friday liturgy on the next day. The hosts intended for the Good Friday service are not placed in the tabernacle, as is usual, but are left on the altar, while the priest says the <u>post communion</u> prayer. The container is then carried in solemn procession to a place of reservation in an appropriately adorned chapel.

Our parish has been served well in previous years in the setting up the altar of repose for us. Assistance is very much needed in this Jubilee Year. Phyllis Truman and Isabel Manuel will be in the hall at Holy Trinity on Holy Thursday morning, 17 April 2025, from 10:00am to coordinate the preparation of the altar of repose. Assistance includes ironing the white cloths, cleaning the brass vases and arranging the sourced flowers. Assistance also involves being able to arrange tables at different heights and placing the tabernacle in place.

At some stage, chairs and kneelers are to be set up for the worshippers. This could be done after Mass on the Wednesday night, with the knowledge that the altar of repose is along the west wall, or on Thursday morning. Please come along and help.
