

JUBILEE OF MUSICAL ENSEMBLES

10 - 11 May 2025,



The purpose of celebrating Musical Ensembles in this Year of Jubilee is to become aware of, and give thanks for, the contribution of those who use their musical skills to support and enhance the liturgy, and to serve the community in other ways.

Teaching

From earliest biblical times, and in different periods, a variety of musical instruments has been used to offer worship to God and sing God's praise.

Today we celebrate the gifts of instrumentalists who help to lead and sustain the singing of the liturgical assembly, whose song is of the utmost importance in praising God.

Music has great power to touch the human heart when words alone do not suffice.

In the liturgy, there are times when instrumental music by itself, skilfully and sensitively played, can open up a beautiful space for the Spirit to work within us. Used in such a way, music in the liturgy has a ministerial role humbly serving the liturgy and the prayer of the assembly, drawing us into active participation through listening and uniting the faithful at a deep level.

So we give thanks today for the gift of our instrumental musicians, for the time and energy they put into preparation – often unknown and unseen – and for giving of their best to enable us all to take our part in the liturgy, and to spread the 'good news' of our faith through music.
