Gospel: Mark 13:24-32

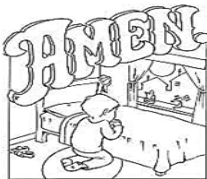
How should we greet Jesus when he comes?

OUR PARISH AND GLEESON COLLEGE

Gleeson College at Golden Grove began in 1989 to cater for the secondary education of students in the outer north-eastern areas of Adelaide. It was initially mainly funded by the Catholic Education Office of our Archdiocese with minor financial contributions from our local parishes.

Much has progressed since then. Today Gleeson is independently and financially viable, providing a top-rate education for 650 students, employing a large competent staff and the facilities are A1.

Unless we have had our own children or grandchildren attending Gleeson, we probably know very little about OUR College. Many of us have driven past it but never seen around its campus.

On **WEDNESDAY, 2nd DECEMBER at 10.00 AM**, the College Principal, Mr Andrew Baker has invited our Parish to Gleeson when he and his staff will show us around. This event is likely to conclude by about 11.00 AM and is exclusively for the Para Hills/ Modbury Parish – it has no other purpose other than to give us the opportunity to see Gleeson. A good attendance by our parishioners will help strengthen the ties between us and Gleeson. It would assist Andrew to set up groups if you give some indication of your attendance by filling in a "sign-up" sheet at the rear of the Church or Centre or to our Church Office or any member of our Parish Pastoral Council.

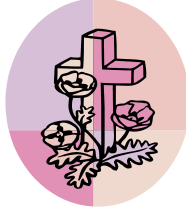
