We Celebrate Mission Sunday

Every October something special happens on the second penultimate (next-to-last) Sunday of October. On this day, the Church reflects its deepest identity as the Church in mission. World Mission Sunday, organised by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to reflect on their own baptism, when they received the gift of faith, and recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. "The great danger in today's world, pervaded as it is by consumerism, is the desolation and anguish born of a complacent yet covetous heart, the feverish pursuit of frivolous pleasures, and a blunted conscience" (Evangelii Gaudium, 2). "Humanity greatly needs to lay hold of the salvation brought by Christ. His disciples are those who allow themselves to be seized ever more by the love of Jesus and marked by the fire of passion for the Kingdom of God and the proclamation of the joy of the Gospel. All the Lord's disciples are called to nurture the joy of evangelization" (*Message of Pope Francis for world mission day*). The Catholic communities are responsible for this proclamation, have the task of promoting the unity of the local Church in her missionary commitment. They are called to acknowledge that the joy of communicating Jesus Christ is expressed in a concern to proclaim him in the most distant places, as well as in a constant outreach to the peripheries of their own areas, where great numbers of the poor are waiting for this message. Many parts of the world are experiencing a dearth of vocations to the priesthood and the consecrated life. Often this is due to the absence of contagious apostolic fervour in communities which lack enthusiasm and thus fail to attract. The joy of the Gospel is born of the encounter with Christ and from sharing with the poor. For this reason, the parish communities, associations and groups should live an intense fraternal life, grounded in love for Jesus and concern for the needs of the most disadvantaged.

It is an important day in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give. "God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Cor 9:7). World Mission Day is also an occasion to rekindle the desire and the moral obligation to take joyful part in the missionary activity of the Church. Every year the needs of the Catholic Church in the Missions grow: as new dioceses are formed, as new seminaries are opened, as areas devastated by war or natural disaster are rebuilt, and as other areas, long suppressed, are opening up to hear the message of Christ and His Church. That is why the involvement and commitment of Catholics from around the world is so urgently needed. Offerings from Catholics in the Archdiocese, on World Mission Sunday and throughout the year, are combined with offerings to the Propagation of the Faith worldwide. A monetary contribution on the part of individuals is the sign of a self-offering, first to the Lord and then to others; in this way a material offering can become a means for the evangelization of humanity built on love. Dear brothers and sisters, on this World Mission Day let us not be robbed of the joy of evangelization! Let us be immersed in the joy of the Gospel and nurture a love that can light up our vocation and our mission. Let us pray that the Church may become a welcoming home, a mother for all peoples and the source of rebirth for our world.

Did you know that **ALL VOLUNTEERS** in the Adelaide Archdiocese are mandated by law to report child abuse and neglect?

In order to ensure all our volunteers are equipped to identify and respond appropriately to concerns about children and young people, we invite any volunteers who have not yet participated in Child Safe Environments training or an equivalent course to attend a 90 minute volunteer briefing session, run by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit. The session will be held at:

The session will inform you about what the Archdiocese is doing to safeguard children and young people and to assist you to recognise signs of abuse, understand how abuse and neglect impact upon children and how to consult about, and if necessary, report child abuse or neglect.

Please note that with respect to child-safe initiatives, as per Archdiocesan Policy, all Extraordinary **Ministers of the Eucharist are required to provide certification of attendance at Child Safe Environments Training.**
