

<u>FEAST DAY OF ST JOHN XXIII</u> Come and join us for this Special Feast Day of St John XXIII

"I want to throw open the windows of the church so that we can see out and the people can see in" These words of St John XXIII brought real changes in the life of the church.

Servus servorum Dei; Servant of the servants of God. This was Pope John's preferred title.

- Birth: 1881 Named Angelo Guiseppe Roncalli 1885 He entered seminary at Bergamo 1904: Ordained as a priest 1944:
 - appointed papal Nuncio to Paris. 1953: He became cardinal-patriarch of Venice.

1958: Nearly 77 years old elected as Pope, chose the name of John after John the Baptist and because it was his father's name, and the name of the church he was baptised in. Pope John XXIII's pontificate lasted less than five years, but it presented him to the entire world as an authentic image of the Good Shepherd. He summoned to meet the Roman Synod, established the Commission for the Revision of the Code of Canon Law and summoned the Second Vatican Council.

Pope John XXIII died on 3rd June 1963, in a spirit of profound trust in Jesus.

Beatified: 3rd September 2000 by Pope John Paul II Canonized: 27th April 2014 by Pope Francis I Feast day: October 11th

There will be a Cuppa after the 6pm Mass on the 13th October and also after the 8am Mass on the 14th October at St John XXIII Church.


