	St Vincent de Paul's Para Hills Conference
	 History – decision was made not to merge conferences when parish merger occurred in 2002. There is some debate about whether this was at Vinnies request or our request of our two Conference members. Given how hard the PPC has been working to bring together the 2 ends of our one parish, having 2 Vinnies Conferences is a source of disunity in the parish – parishioners have to make a decision about whether they will support the Para Hills Conference or the Modbury Conference. Situation at PH's where confrontation has occurred leading to the resignation over time of all of our HT parishioners from the conference. Fr Manu and Carolyn met with Vinnies members and a parishioner to provide support over recent concerns. Carolyn was asked to discuss suggestion re combining two conferences with Michael Bone and Modbury Conf. If agreed this was to be taken as a parish request to Vinnies. Discussion has occurred with Vinnies head office to either join the two regions, or take Para Hills Vinnies off site and then join Parish as one conference. David Wark, CEO of Vinnies SA is considering this proposal. But asked that we put it as a request from the PPC. Proposal – to combine two Parish conferences for Vinnies. No current parishioners attending Para Hills venue. We ask that the boundary be altered by Vinnies to combine conferences. Request for David to attend PPC to discuss this proposal and present relevant information from Vinnies regarding boundaries.
