Adelaide Diocesan Assembly

Archbishop Patrick O'Regan has called a Diocesan Assembly consisting of representatives from the various communities within the Archdiocese of Adelaide to be held in September.

The 2021 Diocesan Assembly has two primary aims:

1. To begin to develop a new vision for our diocese.

The Diocesan Assembly will give us the opportunity to discuss the variety of experiences, challenges and opportunities that shape the life of our local church. Out of these discussions we will begin to form a new vision for the work and mission of the diocese for years to come. This is why your input is so important!

The Diocesan Assembly will also launch a new Diocesan Pastoral Council.

2. To prepare for the Plenary Council in October.

There are seven delegates who will represent the Archdiocese in the Plenary Council. The Diocesan Assembly will help them prepare to represent the people of our diocese. Much of what we will talk about at the Diocesan Assembly will build upon what has been prepared for the Plenary Council.

The Diocesan Assembly agenda will be informed by:

- The 2021 consultation responses
- Data from the Listening and Dialogue phase of the Plenary Council
- The session 1 agenda for the Plenary Council

It is expected that more than 400 participants from parishes, schools, agencies and other communities within the Archdiocese will be invited to attend the assembly.

How can you get involved?

1. Take some time to reflect on the challenges and opportunities in our community by thinking about the question: **"How can we as church best fulfil our mission to the People of God in this place?"** and then sharing your response with the Diocesan Assembly.
2. Ask your parish priest, school, or community leader about being a Diocesan Assembly participant.
3. Volunteer to help out at the Diocesan Assembly
